

PRINCIPLES OF CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES AND SAILORS PARTICIPATING OVERSEAS EVENT

The following principles apply to all sailors and coaches of HKSI or any class associations or clubs participating in overseas training or events which are supported, entered, funded, endorsed or organised by HKSF or HKSI:

- 1. Coaches and sailors should be fully responsible for their own conduct and behaviour when travelling overseas. They must be obliged by local Laws and organization's By-laws.
- 2. The involving coaches and sailors are responsible to handle and settle overseas claims and complaints about their misbehavior or misconduct or breach of laws, by-laws or contract in a satisfactory manner. Failure may result in suspension or immediate dismissal from the team.
- 3. Should there be sufficient evidence from the claimant or from court verdict of any misbehavior or misconduct of the sailor(s) and/or coach(es), HKSF shall commence disciplinary action and inform relevant organisations or HKSI accordingly. This may result in various consequences ranging from a warning, withdrawal of the relevant sailors or coaches from competitions or training events, a suspension of all support from HKSF, or being asked to leave the team immediately.
