

HKSF National Race Officer Requirements

To qualify as NRO, a candidate must:

- be a member of HKSF
- Have completed a NRO seminar or training course and passed the examination
- be recommended by an HKSF member Club
- Have in the 48 months prior to application have been Race Officer[^] at National Level Events for 12 days *
- Have their performance assessed by an existing IRO or NRO using the Assessment Form provided.

Renewal

- be a member of HKSF
- Have in the 48 months prior to application have been Race Officer at National Level Event for 12 days. Each day counts as one point.

*For qualification, the candidate may substitute two Club Level Events for one National Level Event point or four Club Level Events for two National Level events. At least 8 of the 12 required points must be at National Level.

[^]At two of these events, the candidate may have been ARO or DRO. The candidate must have been the Race Officer at the other events.

Club Level Events

To be recognised as a Club Level Event, the event must:

Be organized by an HKSF Member Club or Association

Have issued proper NOR and SIs

Be properly organized, including formal entry and protest procedures

Must have a minimum of 12 entries.
